## **GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS**

- 1. The Show Organisers referred to in these Rules and Regulations shall hereinafter mean “The Pony of the Year Show” and will hereinafter be referred to as the “Show”.**
- 2. All horses/ponies must be registered with British Showjumping**
- 3. The Show, Show Organisers, Volunteers and Officials do not accept liability for any accident, damage, injury, theft or illness to horses/ponies, riders, owners, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever how so ever caused.**
- 4. In each of the 11 & Under, Mini, Pony Introductory, 1m, 110m and Pony Novice Sections, Championship Qualifying Class competitors may qualify for the Grand Prix. Automatic qualifiers are as stated in the Schedule. At the discretion of the Organising Committee additional qualifiers may be nominated in POYS Classes. Qualifiers will be confirmed, following the completion of all qualifying classes via the start lists. Competitors who do not qualify will compete in the Classic section.**
- 5. The Show Organisers retain at its absolute discretion the right to decline or exclude or remove any person or animal from the show or future shows or return any entry fee without being required to assign a reason or being liable for any compensation.**
- 6. Anyone found damaging property or being a nuisance will face immediate expulsion from the show and maybe reported to British Showjumping. All entry fees will be forfeited. Parents must accept responsibility for their children. Any damage must be paid for. All entries and associated fees along with any prize money and prizes in kind will be forfeited.**
- 7. Underage Drinking will not be tolerated under any circumstances and in the event that this is reported or discovered by the Show Organisers the child and anyone responsible and associated with will be sent home immediately and all entries and associated fees along with any prize money and prizes in kind will be forfeited.**
- 8. Membership/stables/entries/hook up will not be accepted without payment in full. Membership and Stable costs are non-refundable. Entry fees will only be refunded if withdrawals are received before the closing date of entries and must be accompanied by a veterinary/doctors certificate.**
- 9. The Show Organisers reserves the right to cancel, add to, or amend any of the competitions, as they think fit, with approval of British Showjumping.**

- 10. Smoking is not permitted within any of the showground buildings or stables.**
- 11. Collecting Rings – All warming up must be done in the designated Collecting Rings. Persons found abusing horses/ponies on the showground will be asked to leave.**
- 12. Refund of Entry and Stable Fees – Refunds will only be in accordance with BS Rule 79.5.1, any cancellations made after the close of entries will be charged the full rate for any Stable, Membership and Hook Up Booking.**
- 13. Stables are nontransferable and may not be sold on to a third party and may only be used by the person booking.**
- 14. Cheques are not accepted.**
- 15. Vehicles – The Show Organisers reserve the right to remove any vehicle which is obstructing any access to or from the showground even if locked and unattended. The Show Organisers will not be liable for any injury, loss or damage occurred by such removal.**
- 16. Dogs are permitted in the Lorry Park only. They must be kept under control and on Leads At All Times. If in the opinion of the Show Organisers any person fails to control their dog/s they maybe asked to leave the showground.**
- 17. Prize Giving – The Show Organisers reserves the right to withhold prizes if competitors do not attend the Official Prize Giving. All classes will hold a mounted Prize Giving.**
- 18. Objections – Objections should be made in writing in accordance with BS Rule 198. Objections should be given to the Show Secretary with a deposit of £100.00, the deposit will be returned to person who objected if the inquiry is found in their favour.**
- 19. Official Photographer – Any Photos taken at the Championship by the Official Photographer maybe used by the Show Organisers for promotional purposes.**
- 20. First Aid – A total of £27.00 per rider for the show will be charged towards medical cover during the hours of competition.**
- 21. Vaccination Certificate – All horses/ponies at the show must have a current valid certificate of vaccination against Equine Influenza. There will be random checks of certificates and any horse/pony found without a valid certificate will be asked to leave the showground.**
- 22. Stallions – No person shall allow a stallion for which he/she is responsible as owner, lessee, authorized agent or rider to compete, in any class without taking adequate precautions to ensure other persons are not put at risk of injury.**
- 23. Close of Entries – Entries will close on the official closing date Monday 23 March 2026.**
- 24. Please note to compete at this show competitors must permanently reside in England, Scotland, Wales and the Channel Islands and invited riders.**
